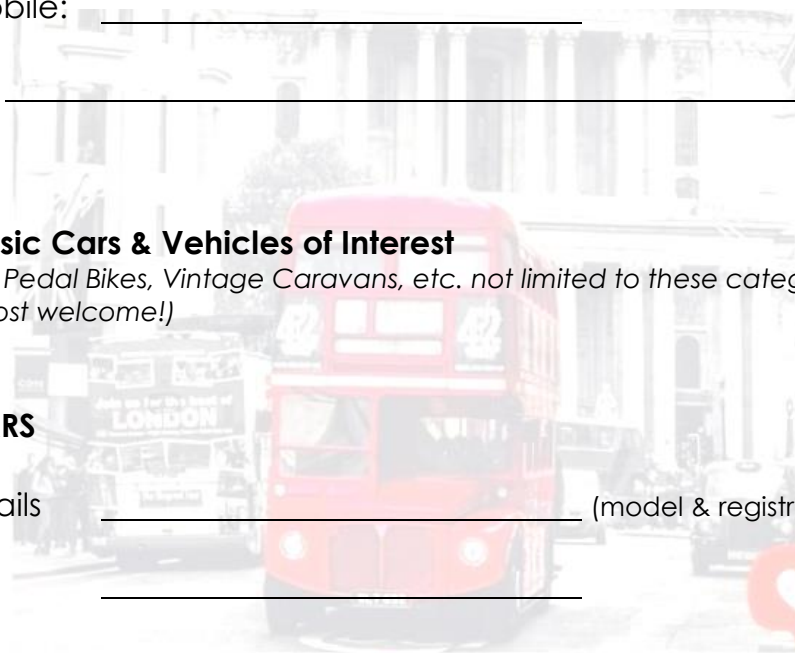

Cowtonbury Classic Car Show

Important Notes:

- We will be camping for the Queen's Jubilee Classic Car Show at the **Cossey Corner Caravan Site, Main Street, East Cowton, DL7 0BP**. This is the same address for the Classic Car event. You will find the entrance to the campsite opposite the Beeswing Inn on the main street. Look out for the North East Branch MMOC flags.
- The North East Branch MMOC is hosting this weekend to help raise funds for both Cowtonbury (raising funds for palliative care pathway) and Prostate Cancer (NEMMOC selected charity), and there are a host of activities planned.
- Camping will be available from 3.30pm Friday 3rd June through to Sunday 5th June. All campers are to depart by latest 5.00pm on Sunday.
- There are no ablution facilities and no electric hook up, therefore camping is restricted to caravans, trailer tents and motorhomes - NO TENTS permitted. There is access to drinking water. Pets are welcome but must be kept on a lead whilst in the field! Please remember to pick up your pets little "parcels", there are Dog Waste Bins in the village on the main street.
- Early arrivals are welcome to visit The Beeswing Inn, should you need refreshments, a leg stretch and a warm and friendly welcome into the village.
- Marshalls will be on hand to direct arrivals on Friday afternoon & Saturday for camping, and on Sunday for the Rally.
- Club stands are permitted, however, may be restricted in numbers of vehicles, due to space limitations. That does not mean your club members cannot come to the village, join in and decorate the Main Street with our lovely Classics.
- Cars must be on the Rally field on Sunday 5th June 2022 by 10.00am. Car owners are asked to remain on the field until at least 3.30pm to ensure public safety. Marshalls will be on site to marshal cars on and off the field (including in emergencies, please reach out to the Rally team, who also have certified First Aiders in situ). Look out for the Hi-viz vests.
